Business Manager's Report

We spent a good portion of May negotiating a 3 year Heavy Highway contract. Each year has an increase of \$1.75 for a total of \$5.25 for the term of the contract. There is also a \$1.50 premium for night work when the shift starts after 6pm.

There will be a Fall outage at Point Beach Nuclear Facility. We don't have exact dates yet, but we are expecting the first call out dates to be in October.

The 30 plus miles of 8" steel pipeline from Plymouth to Chilton is expected to finish up in October. The project is moving well with both good weather and good labor!

School work is also strong in our area. Local #330 has laborers working on schools from Juneau to the Valley and North to Marinette & Niagra. Some of the work is demolition and remodel, while others are new buildings and additions coming out of the ground.

2021 will be a strong year for work. We are looking for hard working new laborers to fill our contractors needs. If you know someone like that, please direct them to our updated website at www.liunalocal330.org and fill out an application.

2021 is shaping up to be a closer to normal year for the Training Center. Training is vital for our jobsite safety and necessary to stay current on certifications. Once the new class schedule is available you can sign up for classes online at training.wislaborers.org

We are planning our first Retirees outing since 2019. August 9th, there will be a boat ride and buffet at the Fin & Feather in Winneconne.


